RULES

- 1. Contestants will be given an event t-shirt after competing. No non-performers will be given a t-shirt.
- 2. Drug and alcohol laws will be enforced.
- 3. Individual competitors may be accompanied by one accompanist only.
- 4. Only acoustic instruments on stage: no electric instruments allowed.
- 5. No amplified music is to be played at any time during
- 6. By performing, all contestants agree that the sponsor may record and reproduce performances free of claim by the contestants. The sponsor has the right to record and reproduce music played at the event.
- 7. If a contestant breaks a string while performing, he must stop immediately; he will be allowed to restring and perform immediately thereafter.
- 8. Golf carts allowed only with drivers 16 and up.
- 9. All ticket sales final. No exchanges or refunds. Lost or damaged wrist bands or mutilated tickets will not be replaced or reimbursed.
- 10. Registration will be accepted up until the end of each competition category only. No one will be allowed to compete in a category once another category has opened.
- 11.No pets allowed off leash.
- 12. One tune only for individual competitors. Two tunes for bands. No medleys.
- 13. Competitors are limited to two individual competition categories and one band only, except for bass players.
- 14. Please list only one contact name for Band competitors. If your band wins a monetary prize, a check will be issued in this person's name. No cash will be distributed. No exceptions.
- 15. There is a 3-minute time limit for individual instrument competitors, 5-minute limit for bands. When time is expired, competitors will be allowed to finish current verse or chorus only.
- 16. Tunes must be part of the public domain or original to the performer only.
- 17. Violation of the above rules may result in the disqualification of a contestant.

DIRECTIONS

From Bluefield: take Hwy 19/460 west through Tazewell, past Exit 1. Continue 1 mile and take first left onto Crab Orchard Rd. Turn right into museum parking lot.

From Abingdon: take Hwy 19/460 east past Claypool Hill toward Tazewell. After going under the train trestle, take next right on Crab Orchard Road, then immediate right into museum parking lot.
